



FREE CURRICULUM-CONNECTED ONLINE RESOURCES FOR GRADES K-12

Calgary Public Library has a variety of online resources to support student learning from home. They are vetted and trusted sources connected to all the core subjects and are available for free. Some, such as Tumblebooks or the Online Reference Centre, might be familiar from school, but there are tons of other great resources to discover in the [Digital Library](#).

How do students and educators access Calgary Public Library eResources?

There are two ways to access the eResources in our Digital Library:


1. The recommended method is with your **free Calgary Public Library card**. If you don't have a Library card you can apply online and receive your membership number immediately.
2. The second method is through **eAccess**. EAccess allows students and educators to use their school email address to login to the resources in our Digital Library.

What are the differences between using eAccess and my Library card to login to eResources?

How do I login using eAccess?

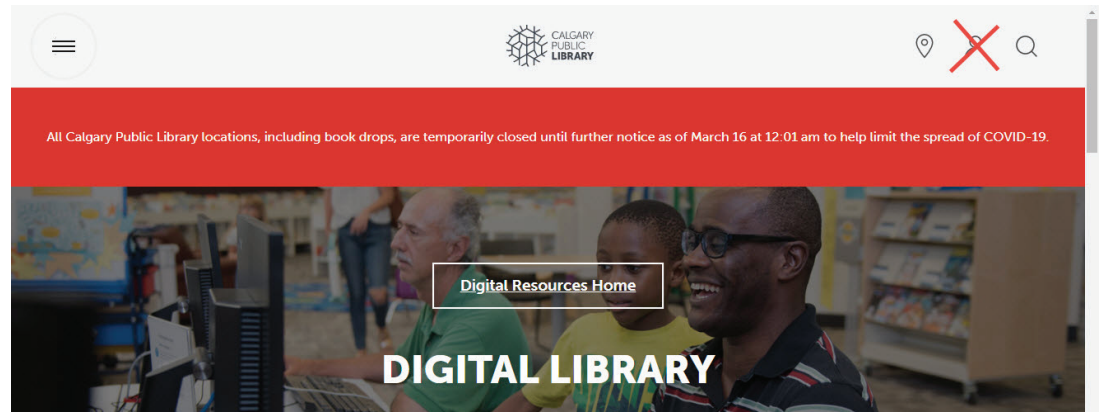
1. Go to <https://calgarylibrary.ca/read-learn-and-explore/digital-library/>
2. Choose and click on an eResource.
3. Click "Access eResource name"
4. eAccess login is slightly different for staff and for students, as well as for CBE and CCSD. Please use the applicable login information:

- **CBE Students** – Where it asks for your card number, enter your entire CBE email address: maryk3@educbe.ca
 - PIN - 1234567
- **CBE Staff** - Where it asks for your card number, enter your entire CBE email address: johnrsmith@cbe.ab.ca
 - PIN - 2222222 (seven digits)
- **CCSD eAccess Students:**
 - **CCSD Grades 1-3**-Where it asks for your card number, enter your entire CCSD email address: johnD1@learn.cssd.ab.ca
 - PIN - 1234567
 - **CCSD Grades 4-6**-Where it asks for your card number, enter your entire CCSD email address: johnD1@learn.cssd.ab.ca
 - PIN - individual student ID number.
- **CCSD eAccess Staff** - At the request of CCSD, eAccess for educators was not created under the assumption they would instead apply for Library cards.
- **If Charter or Private (outside the CBE or CCSD systems):** Students may login with their Library card number and personal PIN.

Help! eAccess doesn't work when I try to login to the Library's website.

If you try to login with eAccess by clicking on the person icon on the top right of your screen, it will not work. This is the Library's online catalogue and only works for Library card numbers. Instead, visit the Digital Library page and click on the eResource you wish to use, and login with eAccess from there.



What if I can't remember my Library card PIN number or have problems logging in with eAccess?

I live outside of Calgary city limits. How do I access curriculum-connected eResources?

Indigenous populations living on First Nations or Métis settlements have full access to Calgary Public Library eResources through a Library card. If you live outside of Calgary, in another municipality, access to eResources is licensed for you by your local library system. Please refer to your local public library.
